Administration of LEUSTATIN (cladribine) for Injection: LEUSTATIN must be diluted in designated intravenous solution prior to administration (See DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION) Benzyl alcohol as a Diluent: Benzyl alcohol is a constituent of the recommended diluent for the 7-day infusion solution

#### **Product Quality Review(s)**

Cladribine was first marketed within the US by Janssen Pharmaceuticals as Leustatin® Injection 10 mg/mL for IV infusion to treat active Hairy Cell Leukemia (NDA 20229, approved 2/26/1993) The applicant, EMD Serono (EMD) assumed sponsorship of and continued clinical development of cladribine, as a tablet formulation, under IND 74634 EMD

Cladribine (Leustatin ) Not required 0.22 micron filter (see comment) Recommend using a 0.22 micron filter to prepare a 7-day infusion only It is not necessary to use a 0.22 micron filter for preparation of single daily dose Do not use D5W as a diluent as it increases cladribine degradation 1, 2, 3
